GENERAL TERMS OF "CANCELLATION INSURANCE"

The warranty takes effect immediately after the signing of the lease contract and expires at midnight prior to the first day of your stay. Provided that the contractual obligations are complied, the guarantee allows you to obtain a refund of the amount paid, if your trip must be cancelled due to one of the following cases from the exhaustive list below:

- → Serious illness, personal injury or death:
- Regarding yourself, your spouse or partner, your ascendants or descendants, your guardian,
- Your brothers, sisters, brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, sons-in-law, daughters-in-law, stepfathers, stepmothers

By serious illness or bodily injury we mean any temporary or permanent damage to your physical integrity, observed medically and implying the termination of all professional or other activity.

- → Pregnancy problems
- → ⊠Serious problems requiring your presence on the day of the scheduled departure due to theft, fire, water or natural disaster, damage to your main residence or your business premises destroyed by more than 50%. (Insurance certificate to be provided)
- → ⊠Redundancy regarding yourself or your spouse provided that the procedure has not been initiated prior to booking your stay.

All these grounds for annulling must be notified by letter accompanied by any necessary documents establishing the facts (expert report, observation by police authorities, summoning, medical or death certificate, etc...) upon incident, and no later than 3 business days following the incident or event.

In the case of force majeure, Camping La Digue may not be able to honor its engagemnts, in this case Camping La Digue reserves the right to cancel bookings and give a full refund, without liability for any further claim.

MAIN EXCLUSIONS

- Consequences due to complications or worsening of an illness or an accident discovered prior to signing the contract.
- The announcement of a pregnancy, abortion, childbirth and its normal consequences
- Drug addiction, alcoholism and its consequences
- Mental or psychic illnesses, or nervous disorders that do not result in hospitalisation for more than 7 days
- Wilful and deliberate acts
- Accidents resulting from the practice of any sport or competition professionally, as well as training and preparation
- Accidents resulting from amateur practice, and at all levels of the following motor sports (car, motorcycle, any motor vehicle), aerial sports
- Epidemics, pollution, natural disasters stipulated in the July 13th 1982 N-82.600 law act
- Civil or foreign war, riots, uprisings, strikes, acts of terrorism, and the consequences of exposure to radioactivity
